## DEBS 2026: Abstracts and Interesting Cases contest on DCB

### Submission Guidelines-*deadline 11.30.25*

#### 1. Abstract structure

- Title
- Background / Introduction – State the clinical problem, rationale, or hypothesis.
- Methods – Describe study design, population, intervention(s), and statistical methods.
- Results – Provide key findings with statistical significance (N, %, p-values). Include a maximum of 1 figure OR 1 table.
- Conclusions – End with a clear "In conclusion..." sentence. Emphasize clinical/research implications.
- *For Interesting Cases only*: do not follow the Abstracts structure: describe one or more interesting and educational case which pertains DCB PCI.

#### 2. Length and format rules

- Maximum length: 250 words.
- Figures/Tables: Only 1 figure OR 1 table allowed.

#### 3. Authorship and presenter rules

- The 5 best abstracts will be presented in person in a main session of the DEBS congress, and the first 3 classified will get a scholarship.
- All the accepted abstracts will be published in Journal of SCAI in a dedicated Supplement.
- The First Author of all accepted abstracts must register and attend the congress

#### 4. Submission process

- Language: English only.
- Submissions undergo plagiarism and data-integrity screening.
- Deadline for submission: November 30th 2025.
- Acceptance notification: December 15th 2025.
- The Advisory Board will select the abstracts to be published, whereas a specific jury during DEBS will select the 3 winners of the contest. The Advisory Board will thereafter strongly encourage and support the publication of the best 3 abstracts of DEBS 2026.
